- ✓ Students must document a minimum of 30 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction, including at least 10 hours of instruction that takes place at night with an adult.
- ✓ This is a concurrent program so that students can apply classroom education and the behind-the-wheel during the same time.
- ✓ This course satisfies the state requirements for teen driver education.
